



India's Economic Resilience: GST 2.0, Fiscal Discipline, and Growth Amid Global Challenges

India's economy is doing well as the fiscal year draws to a close. Firm fiscal discipline and historic tax reforms are important motivators. The 2026 budget is being prepared by Finance Minister Nirmala Sitaraman. Economic stability and strategic spending will be the main priorities of this budget. There are issues on a global scale. Following rate reductions, GST collections are stable. This suggests improved compliance and continued economic activity.

Thanks to significant tax reforms and strict budgetary control, the Indian economy is ending the fiscal year with robust growth.

This impressive domestic performance coincides with Finance Minister Nirmala Sitaraman's preparations for Budget 2026, which is anticipated to reaffirm the government's dedication to strategic spending and economic stability in the face of numerous complex global challenges.

Budget 2026: GST collections hold steady after rate cuts

The government's Goods and Services Tax (GST) collections have displayed noteworthy stability in the current fiscal year (FY2025-26), even after the comprehensive GST 2.0 rate rationalisation implemented in September 2025.

Gross GST revenue for November 2025 was recorded at Rs 1,70,276 crore, marking a marginal increase of 0.7% year-on-year. While this represents the slowest growth in the fiscal year, officials note that the collections are broadly on expected lines following the sweeping rate cuts. Crucially, cumulative gross collections from April to November 2025 reached Rs 14,75,488 crore, demonstrating a robust 8.9% annual growth. This is the sustained performance is a significant indicator of ongoing economic activity and better compliance.

Union Budget: The impact of 'GST 2.0'

The stability in collections follows the biggest overhaul of the indirect tax system since its 2017 inception.

GST 2.0 simplified the multi-tiered structure into a streamlined system, primarily featuring a 5% 'merit rate' for essentials and an 18% 'standard rate' for most other goods and services, alongside a new 40% rate for select luxury items.

The reform was pitched as a major consumption booster, directly reducing taxes on essential goods like personal care products, packaged food items, and even certain small cars, leaving more disposable income in the hands of consumers. While the short-term goal of boosting household spending appears to be driving taxable value growth, the government is closely monitoring collection trends to assess the full long-term impact.



Budget 2026 to follow fiscal roadmap

The healthy tax revenue stream places Finance Minister Sitaraman in a strong position to adhere to the government's fiscal glide path.

The Budget 2025 had already set the fiscal deficit target for FY2026 at 4.4% of GDP, aligning with the commitment to narrow the gap to below 4. The Budget is expected to continue focusing on high capital expenditure (capex), which was targeted at a record Rs 11.21 lakh crore for the previous fiscal year, as a primary engine for sustainable, long-term economic growth, particularly through infrastructure development.

Budget News: Global headwinds & domestic resilience

India's economic fundamentals remain a beacon of strength against a backdrop of global economic uncertainty, including geopolitical tensions in the Middle East and Europe, persistently high inflation in many developed economies, and a significant trade shock from the United States.

A major external challenge is the aggressive tariff policy implemented by the US administration in 2025. Following an initial 25% duty, the US hiked tariffs on a large portion of Indian exports to 50% by late August, making Indian goods among the most heavily taxed of any major US trading partner.

This measure, partly linked to geopolitical friction over India's continued imports of Russian oil, has severely impacted bilateral trade.

Meanwhile, back home, the narrative of India's economy has shifted from mere resilience to accelerated growth, while inflation has eased significantly, altering the Reserve Bank of India's (RBI) monetary policy calculus. Far from experiencing a deceleration, the Indian economy delivered a major upside surprise, accelerating to a six-quarter high in the second quarter of the current fiscal year (FY2025-26) as it quickened to 8.2%, beating estimates.

This robust performance was driven primarily by a surge in the manufacturing sector, which grew 9.1% year-on-year, and strong expansion in the services sector. The momentum was supported by private consumer spending (which accounts for nearly 60% of GDP) and continued high government capital expenditure.

However, the upcoming Budget, the third in Prime Minister Narendra Modi's third term, faces the unique challenge of balancing national growth objectives with the priorities of the established coalition government.

From Festivity to Responsibility: Youth Fests as Green Cultural Movements

A university cultural youth fest represents the vibrant pulse of campus life, where enthusiasm, creativity, and youthful energy converge into a celebration of talent and togetherness. It is a platform where students express their identities through music, dance, drama, literature, and art, transcending academic boundaries and routine classroom interactions. Such festivals nurture unity, mutual respect, and collective joy, strengthening bonds among students from diverse cultural, social, and regional backgrounds.

Cultural festivals also serve as mirrors of tradition and diversity. They showcase folk art forms, regional customs, indigenous knowledge, and cultural values that bind society together. Youth fests celebrate pluralism and inclusivity, fostering a shared sense of belonging. However, in the present era of climate change and environmental degradation, it is essential to rethink how we celebrate. The challenge before us is to transform joyful festivities into environmentally responsible events, where culture thrives in harmony with nature rather than at its cost.

Tribal Cultural Practices as Models for Green Events

Tribal communities have long practiced celebrations that are inherently eco-friendly, resource-efficient, and deeply respectful of nature. Their cultural traditions may offer valuable lessons for organizing sustainable youth festivals today. Rather than relying on synthetic materials or excessive consumption, tribal practices emphasize simplicity, reuse, and coexistence with the environment.

One of the most common practices in tribal households is the use of fresh mango leaves to decorate walls and entrances during festivals and auspicious occasions. These leaves symbolize prosperity and purity while being completely biodegradable. Guests are traditionally welcomed with water kept in a brass pot adorned with mango leaves, reflecting hospitality rooted in ecological consciousness. The use of brass, a durable and reusable metal, further minimizes waste generation.

In many tribal rituals, mustard oil is gently applied while welcoming guests as a mark of respect and well-being. Natural and locally sourced, mustard oil replaces artificial perfumes and chemical products. Invitations are often marked by the symbolic application of rice flour and turmeric paste, both biodegradable and culturally significant. Turmeric, known for its antiseptic properties, symbolizes purity, health, and positivity.



Traditionally, guests are invited personally by visiting their homes, strengthening social bonds while eliminating paper or plastic invitations. During such visits, details of the program are shared, and a small quantity of turmeric dipped in rice is handed over, wrapped carefully in a *Shorea robusta* (Sal) leaf. This practice reflects respect for nature by using locally available leaves as natural packaging.

Event venues or pandals are constructed using tree trunks as pillars and covered with leafy twigs, creating temporary structures that blend seamlessly with the surroundings and leave no permanent ecological damage. Guests are welcomed with marigold flower garlands, which are natural, fragrant, and compostable. Food is traditionally served in handmade leaf plates and bowls, locally known as **paatal** and **doona**, which return to the soil after use, completing a natural cycle.

Beyond ceremonies, tribal communities demonstrate profound ecological wisdom in daily life. Bamboo, for instance, is cut in a way that allows regeneration of the plant. Tribal life is guided by the principle of preserving “**Jungle, Jal aur Jameen**”—forests, water, and land. These traditions remind us that environmental conservation is not a modern concept but an inherited responsibility.

Environmental Challenges Linked to Modern Celebrations

Despite such rich ecological heritage, modern celebrations often generate serious environmental concerns. Plastic decorations, thermocol structures, disposable cutlery, and excessive packaging from food stalls contribute to mounting waste. Excessive use of paper for posters, passes, and pamphlets leads to unnecessary depletion of natural resources. Food wastage during large gatherings further raises environmental and ethical issues.

Moreover, loud sound systems, diesel generators, and excessive lighting cause noise and air pollution, increasing the carbon footprint of events. If left unmanaged, such celebrations contradict the very spirit of harmony they seek to promote. Recognizing these challenges is the first step towards responsible fest planning.

Youth as Agents of Green Change

Youth possess the energy, creativity, and moral responsibility to lead sustainable transformations. University youth fests provide a powerful platform to translate environmental awareness into action. When young people adopt eco-friendly practices, they influence peers, families, and communities, creating a ripple effect of positive change.

Through innovation, artistic expression, and collective effort, youth can redefine celebrations. Green ideas—whether in stage décor, waste management, or cultural performances—demonstrate how creativity can align with sustainability. As future leaders, students have the potential to turn environmental responsibility into a lifestyle rather than a slogan.

Eco-Friendly Practices

Sustainability does not demand grand sacrifices but practical, achievable choices. Using biodegradable or reusable décor, promoting cloth banners instead of flex, opting for leaf plates or earthen cups, and encouraging digital invitations significantly reduce waste. Waste segregation into wet and dry categories, minimal use of electricity, and reliance on natural lighting further reduce environmental impact.



Plants play a crucial role in carbon sequestration, air purification, and climate regulation. Green spaces reduce stress, enhance aesthetics, and improve mental well-being. Activities such as tree plantation drives, herbal garden exhibitions, seed ball distribution, and displays of native plant diversity during youth fests bridge science, tradition, and sustainability.

From Celebration to Commitment

True celebration is one that respects and protects nature. When cultural joy aligns with ecological responsibility, festivals become meaningful movements rather than mere events. Inspired by tribal wisdom and driven by youthful innovation, every youth fest can become a green quest. Small, conscious actions taken today can ensure a healthier, greener tomorrow—making our celebrations not just memorable, but responsible.

P. K. Roy Memorial College, Dhanbad, has been instrumental in shaping my academic foundation, professional trajectory, and value system. As an alumnus of the Department of Psychology, having completed both B.A. (Honours) and M.A. in Psychology from this institution, I acknowledge with deep gratitude the structured academic environment, committed faculty, and holistic opportunities that enabled my intellectual growth, leadership development, social orientation, and a lifelong commitment to learning. Many competencies that I later came to recognise as essential 21st century skills were cultivated here, often unconsciously, through a balanced integration of academics, culture, and community engagement.

During my undergraduate years, Dr. R. S. Yadav, Dr. Prem Kumar Jaiswal, and Dr. Kavita Singh (presently the Principal) ensured continuity in teaching, rigorous discussion, and individual academic mentoring. Each of these three teachers possessed distinct personalities and pedagogical strengths, and all three played a formative role in my life. Dr. Yadav, the then Head of the Department, believed deeply in excellence; his critical observations, high expectations, and emphasis on academic discipline constantly challenged students to do better. Dr. Jaiswal always placed student welfare at the centre of his academic thinking, extending guidance with warmth. Dr. Singh maintained an approachable and supportive academic environment, combining firmness with empathy and personal engagement. Their sustained efforts strengthened my conceptual clarity, analytical ability, and habit of disciplined study, and motivated me to continue in psychology as a field of higher learning and research.

My postgraduate years coincided with the growing recognition of the college as a reputed centre for postgraduate education in the region. With increased academic diversity, I remained actively engaged in classroom learning while also taking responsibility in co-curricular and institutional activities. I was frequently involved in conducting quizzes, coordinating auditions for youth festivals, organising cultural programmes, and supporting activities related to National Youth Day, blood donation camps, and other important observances. These engagements gradually strengthened my organisational abilities, leadership skills, communication competence, and sense of institutional responsibility.

Participation in Youth Festivals from 2010 to 2016, particularly in literary events and theatre, remains one of the most influential aspects of my college life. In one-act plays and skits, learning extended far beyond performance. Along with my friends, I spent long days and nights in the college preparing backdrops, creating props, rehearsing scripts, and managing logistics.



Theatre taught me teamwork, emotional expression, discipline, creativity, and the ability to work under pressure - lessons that continue to guide me personally and professionally.

In 2010, my first year, a group of 20 students from our college participated in the Youth Festival hosted by Visthapit College, Bokaro, where the institution won four awards. I was fortunate to receive two of them, in collage making and quiz. Subsequently, I represented the university at the Inter-University Youth Festival at the University of Kalyani. In the years that followed, with better planning, timely preparation, and institutional support including budget allocation, P. K. Roy Memorial College emerged as the overall champion at the university level repeatedly. This sustained success reflected a culture of planning, teamwork, and shared responsibility between students and teachers. Youth festivals and cultural activities also gave me friendships that have endured over time. Many of these friends are today contributing positively in diverse areas of society. It was through this companionship that I developed a lasting appreciation for classical music, theatre, and literature.

I had the opportunity to work closely with several faculty members in organising youth festivals and institutional activities, including Dr. Dhananjay Kumar Singh, Dr. Rajeev Pradhan, Dr. Md. Mausoo Ahmad, and Dr. Dharmendra Kumar Singh. Their guidance and trust allowed students to take initiative while learning the importance of coordination, accountability, and disciplined execution.

A significant component of my holistic development came through active involvement in the National Service Scheme (NSS) under the guidance of Prof. Mukund Ravidas. Through NSS, I participated in several camps such as Special Camp at New Islampur, blood donation camps, voter awareness programmes, and various community outreach activities. I was selected as a Campus Ambassador under SVEEP (Election Commission of India) and, after formal training at SIRD, Ranchi, worked in coordination with the district administration under the then Deputy Commissioner, Dhanbad, Mr. Prashant Kumar. These experiences enhanced my civic awareness, leadership capacity, and understanding of democratic processes.

I had the opportunity to join the National Cadet Corps (NCC), which gave me valuable experiences, but I found that my primary engagement thrived with the National Service Scheme (NSS), where I could immerse myself in its strong community-oriented learning environment. At the national level, participation in the National Mega Camp at Tezpur University brought me into contact with students from across States and Union Territories, friendships that remain intact even today. The camp instilled confidence, inclusive approach, and leadership skills in me. I also had the honour of representing my university at the Pre-Republic Day Parade Camp, Agra, an experience that deepened my sense of national integration and responsibility. At the state level, I represented the institution at the first Jharkhand Youth Festival held at Khelgaon, Ranchi, where I secured Second Prize in Extempore. This experience strengthened my confidence in public speaking and spontaneous expression, skills that later became central to my academic and professional life.

My academic interests were further refined through regular participation in national seminars conducted by Dr. Praveen Kumar Singh, Department of Political Science and other



professors. These seminars provided my first exposure to academic research writing and paper presentation. Through them, I had the opportunity to interact with scholars such as Prof. Ajay Kumar, Department of Adult Education, Jawaharlal Nehru University, whose brief yet impactful interaction shaped my political awareness. I was also deeply influenced by Prof. Rizwan Qaisar, Department of History and Culture, Jamia Millia Islamia, whose perspectives broadened my understanding of historical and socio-cultural processes.

Among all the influences in my college life, Prof. Devendra Kumar Choubey occupies a special place. Though he never taught me formally in a classroom, he became an integral part of my intellectual and personal journey. Through shared travels, extended discussions, and reflections on social, political, and philosophical issues, he embodied democratic, progressive, and humanistic values. His thinking has profoundly shaped my philosophy of life, and I consciously strive to pass on these values to my own students.

The collective mentorship of the Psychology faculty and the wider academic community at my college helped me recognise my potential, build self-esteem, and strengthen self-efficacy. It provided an environment where academic learning, research exposure, cultural participation, peer collaboration, and social responsibility naturally complemented one another.

Building on this strong foundation, I have qualified UGC-NET and CTET, completed a Postgraduate Diploma in Clinical Psychology, earned a Bachelor of Education, and completed my Ph.D. in Psychology from Patna University. I have authored several academic research papers and participated in numerous national and international conferences. Presently, I am a teacher where I endeavour to integrate academic rigor, ethical values, participative collaborative learning, and learner-centred pedagogy deeply rooted in the education I received at my alma mater. My journey stands as a testament to the fact that when an institution nurtures intellect, culture, and values together, it prepares students not only for careers but for life.
